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GENERAL INFORMATION, MODE OF APPLICATION AND REQUIREMENTS

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Introduction

Agricultural production forms the backbone of Kenya's economy. It is this realization that prompted the Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology (JKUAT) to organize seminars for farmers between 1991 and 1993 in conjunction with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

Among those technical courses, JKUAT organized the course specifically targeted for rural women leaders called "Improved and Sustainable Agricultural Productivity for Women Farmers" for five (5) years from 1994 - 1998.

From the experience of the course, the Farm of JKUAT realised the need to strengthen the capacity of rural women, who play a key role in rural life as a whole including agriculture, health and nutrition, environment conservation, income generation etc. From this point of view, a training programme for comprehensive strengthening of rural women's capacity, called "Strengthening of Rural Women's Capacity for Community Development" was proposed for the basis of the JICA's Incountry Training scheme to be held at JKUAT Farm annually for 5 years. JICA accepted to fund the program from 2000 to 2004.

2. Duration

The first course was held from 7th January, 2001 to 10th February 2001. The second course will be held from 6th January to 9th February 2002.

3. Participants

The total number of participants will be fifty (50), drawn from the areas as shown in ANNEX V for the year 2001. District Social Development Officers (DSDOs) from the respective districts will be invited for the last five days of the course for the follow-up purpose. Two women from the same district as a set will be nominated for the course so that they are able to discuss with each other on the problems they face and make better proposals.

4. Purpose

This course is designed for rural women. It covers comprehensive, fundamental, theoretical and practical training in improvement of rural life and rural women's empowerment. The course provides comprehensive approach toward strengthening of rural women's capacity for sustainable community development by acquiring methodologies of analysis of their rural life and countermeasures for problems they are facing, technical know-how of agriculture, health, environment, nutrition and any related issues. The participants are also expected to earn sufficient knowledge and skills for formulating specific project proposals suitable to their own community.

5. Objectives

At the end of the course, the participants are expected to have;

- i) acquired knowledge regarding social, cultural and historical background of gender issues in Kenya.
- ii) acquired skills to identify and analyze problems which women face in local areas
- iii) acquired specific problem solving skills for each related field.

- iv) acquired improved farming methods in order to increase their agricultural productivity.
- v) planned and formulated model projects.

6. Training programme

- i) The outline of the training programme and schedule are shown in Annex I and II
- ii) The course will be conducted in Kiswahili and/or English
- iii) The course is subject to review from time to time depending on the needs of the participants.

7. Venue of training

The training will be carried out at JKUAT situated in Juja, approximately 10 km from Thika towards Nairobi and 40 km from Nairobi towards Thika.

The Farm department will be responsible for conducting and coordinating the course.

8. Certificate

The participants who successfully complete the course will be awarded a Certificate of Attendance by JICA/JKUAT.

II. CONDITIONS FOR APPLICATION

1. Requirements for application

The training organizing committee of JKUAT will invite suitable personnel from the Women's Groups, registered and approved by presently the Ministry of Home Affairs, Heritage and Sport, as well as the District where they reside in. The requirements for participation are as follows:

- i) To be nominated by the District Social Development Officers
- ii) Women who are devoted and take leading roles in rural women group involved in social development activities
- iii) The age should be under 50 years or thereabout
- iv) The person should be able to write and communicate in Kiswahili or English
- v) To be in good health both physically and mentally in order to complete the course. No chronic cases will be allowed.
- vi) A person who is eager to obtain new knowledge and techniques in community activities and pass the same to other women for rural development.
- vii) A person who is ready and willing to cooperate with other participants during the training
- viii) No political activities should be carried out during the course
- ix) The participants will be required to sign for the course regulations on arrival
- x) Not to have been nominated/recruited during the previous course on incountry training programme on women farmers.

2. Procedure for application

- i) JKUAT will send the General Information (GI) Forms to the DSDOs of the selected districts
- ii) The DSDOs will distribute the GI Forms to the Women groups within the district
- iii) The DSDOs will receive the GI application forms with their comments for each nominee to JKUAT.

- iv) The DSDO will send the selected five (5) applicants' name together with their forms duly filled and signed to JKUAT by 31st October, 2001.
- v) The JKUAT will inform the successful applicants through the DSDO by 30th November 2001.
- vi) A sample of the application form duly filled is given (ANNEX III)
- vii) Application forms are attached (ANNEX IV).

Note; Rural women leaders where JICA has a cooperation programme will have an added advantage.

III. ALLOWANCES AND EXPENSES (To be borne by JICA)

- i) A single return transport expenses
- ii) A per diem of Kshs.250.00 per day will be provided (payable weekly)
- iii) Other expenses will be treated in accordance with JICA's rules and regulations
- iv) Accommodation will be provided in the Halls of residence at JKUAT.

IV. OTHER INFORMATION

1. General facilities

- i) Public telephone booths are situated at convenient points within the Campus
- ii) Mail services are available at the University mail bureau
- iii) Meals will be served at the University cafeteria. No special diet will be provided.

2. General information

- i) Participants are expected to strictly observe the laws of Kenya
- ii) Participants are expected to strictly observe the course schedule and its regulations
- iii) Requests to extend the training or period of stay will not be accepted
- iv) Expectant (pregnant) mothers do not qualify for the course
- v) Participants must not bring any dependents to the training
- vi) For the administrative purposes, the participants will be requested to take photographs at JKUAT (during the course)
- vii) JKUAT is situated on Thika-Nairobi highway at Juja Township 40 km from Nairobi and 10 km from Thika. The participants will be expected to arrive for the course from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Sunday 6th January, 2002.
- viii) Stationery and work clothes will be provided during the course.

I. MAELEZO KWA JUMLA

1. Utangulizi

Kilimo ni uti wa mgongo wa uchumi wa Kenya. Ni kutokana na kuelewa huku ndio chuo kikuu cha Jomo Kenyatta cha Kilimo na Teknolojia (JKUAT) kilianzisha semina kwa wakulima kati ya mwaka wa tisaini na moja hadi tisaini na tatu.

Kutokana na ujuzi huu, idara ya 'Farm' ya JKUAT iliona umuhimu wa kutilia mkazo uwezo wa wanawake wa kutoka sehemu za mashambani ambao huchangia, kwa sehemu kubwa katika kilimo, afya, lische bora, kulinda mazingira, njia za kupata mapato na kadhalika ndio masomo haya yakapendekezwa kwa mnajili wa 'JICA's Incountry Training Scheme' kufanywa katika idara ya Farm kutoka mwaka wa elfu mbili hadi mwaka wa elfu mbili na nne.

2. Mda

Masomo ya kwanza yaliaanza tarehe saba Januari mwaka wa elfu mbili na moja (07-01-2001) hadi tarehe kumi mwezi wa pili mwaka wa elfu mbili na moja (10-02-2001). Kozi ya pili itaanza tarehe 6/01/2002 hadi tarehe 9/02/2002.

3. Wahusika

Masomo haya ni ya viongozi wa makundi ya akina mama. Jumla ya wahusika itakuwa hamsini (50) kutoka maeneo mbali mbali, kama inavyoonyeshwa katika Annex IV ya mwaka wa elfu mbili na moja. Maafisa wa DSDO kutoka Wilaya mbalimbali wataalikwa katika siku tano za mwisho za kozi kwa lengo la kufuatilizia. Kutoka kila wilaya kutachaguliwa wanawake wawili ili waweze kujadiliana na kuweza kuandika mapendekezo bora.

4. Madhumuni ya masomo

Kozi hii ni ya wanawake. Inagusia kwa undani mafundisho ya darasani na ya vitendo ili kufanya maisha ya mashambani ya wakulima kuwa bora zaidi, na hata kufanya wanawake kuwa na nguvu zaidi. Kozi hii inatilia mkazo' kujiendeleza kwa akina mama wa mashambani kupitia kwa njia mbali mbali za kuchanangua maisha yao na shida zinazowakabili. Ufahamu wa kilimo, afya, mazingira, lische bora na mambo kama hayo. Wakulima pia wanatarajiwa kupata ufahamu na ujuzi wa kuanzisha mapendekezo ya miradi itakayoweza kusaidia jamii zao.

5. Malengo halisi

Baada ya masomo haya mshiriki anatakiwa awe amepata;

- iii) Taratibu itakaguliwa mara kwa mara kulingana na mahitaji ya wahusika

7. Mahali pa mafundisho

Mafundisho yatakuwa katika chuo kikuu cha Jomo Kenyatta cha Ukulima na Teknolojia (JKUAT) ambacho kiko katika kijiji cha Juja kilomita arubaini (40 km) kutoka Nairobi kuelekea Thika, na kama kilomita kumi (10 km) kutoka Thika. Idara ya *Farm* ndio itakayoandaa na kutekeleza masomo.
